Get involved and work across Scotland investigating how young people deal with debt, savings and credit.

What is the project about?

Young Scot has teamed up with the Carnegie UK Trust to look at how young people think about and use credit*. This could be anything from a store card, credit card and overdrafts to loans and phone contracts.

Supported by Young Scot, a group of young people will take a lead role in the project representing the youth voice in Scotland.

**If you buy goods or services on credit, it means that someone like a bank or other lender has given you the money to pay for something that you need to pay back at a later date.*

To do this you will:

- » **Meet regularly** as a national team and also work together online
- » Conduct your own **investigation**
- » Support Young Scot to **run workshops** that will **engage other young people** in the project
- » **Encourage young people** to share their own experiences
- » **Create Recommendations** and actions for Carnegie UK Trust to make sure financial services are relevant and appropriate for young people

The project will run from the end of August to December 2017, with introduction sessions on the 14th and 18th September.

This project will give you the chance to challenge yourself, be innovative and make your CV stand out from the crowd!

- » Increase your confidence - be empowered and challenge the people at the top!
- » Meet other people from across Scotland and work in a team
- » Have your say on the future of services affecting all Scottish young people
